Neurocognitive Testing: What To Expect

The next step in the ABC process is the Neurocognitive Testing. When you come in for your Neurocognitive Testing appointment, the technician will administer several different computer-based tests of different focus and a couple paper self-evaluative forms. These tests can be done in any order and measure many different aspects of mental health, including:

- Visual Processing
- Auditory Processing
- Working Memory
- Cognitive Flexibility
- Sustained Attention
- Verbal Memory
- Processing Speed
- Reaction Time
- Complex Attention
- Composite Memory
- Executive Function

The technician will stay with you to answer any questions you have with the tests and provide any guidance necessary, though you must answer all the questions yourself (or with the help of a parent or legal guardian) based on your own experiences and opinions. After this testing, Dr. Bullard and the rest of the Acuity Brain Center team will review your Neurocognitive Testing results and QEEG results and prepare a report. You will receive a call to schedule a review with Dr. Bullard, during which he will discuss with you your results, his findings, and the next steps on your journey to a healthy brain!
